Parking Lot Speed Reminder



It has been noted that some people approach, enter and drive in the IC School/Parish parking lot at a higher speed than is mandatory. **In BC, the speed limit in marked SCHOOL ZONES is 30km and is effect from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on school days.** While **PARKING LOT SPEEDS** are recommended at a very slow, cautious pace, generally **20km or lower**. Unless you have a formal placard on your mirror, please do not park in spaces that are designated as accessible parking.
