SHARE HOPE



Children's Liturgy of the	The leader of Children's Liturgy facilitates the 'Liturgy of the Word for Children'. The
Word	Sunday Gospel and readings are proclaimed at a level the children can understand so as
	to experience God's love for them. The Liturgy of the Word is enriched with discussion,
	activities, prayers, and songs. Training, resources, and support are provided for those who provide this ministry.
Church Art & Environment	Ministers of Art & Environment are called to serve the parish in preparing an
	environment that enables reverence and the worship and honor of our God. These
	ministers care for the worship space, ensuring that the environment appropriately
	represents what we celebrate in the sacraments, rites, and the liturgical seasons and
	feasts of the Church Year.
Extraordinary Minsters of	The Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion (EMC) assists the priest in the
Holy Communion (EMC)	distribution of Holy Communion. EMCs receive formation and training which
	emphasizes the importance of this specific ministry and the reverence and decorum that it requires.
Hospitality Ministry	The Hospitality Ministry helps to provide a welcoming atmosphere at our parish. In
	addition to being greeters at Sunday Mass, the Hospitality Ministers connect guests and newcomers to parish resources and coordinate the gift bearers and ushers.
Hosting Sunday Coffee	Those hosting Sunday Coffee provide an opportunity for parishioners to socialize after
	Mass. Working as a team of two to four people—they set up, make, and serve coffee
	and treats and clean up. If there are enough teams – a team would serve once a
	month.
Lector	The Lector Ministry calls for the proclamation of the Word of God at Mass and other
	liturgical celebrations. The hearing of God's Word, which is living and active, enable us
	to grow in the knowledge of Scripture and incorporate its message into our daily living.
	Lectors are urged to pray with the Sunday readings prior to proclaiming them, and to



	then read scripture in a clear and meaningful way so that everyone can hear and understand how God is speaking to us in his living Word. Lectors receive formation and training.
Music Ministry Leaders of song	The Leaders of Song enhance the liturgical celebrations by directing the music at Mass through hymns and songs that will ensure the "full, conscious, and active participation"
	of the parishioners in the liturgical celebration (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 14). The whole parish community benefits from participating in the Mass through prayerful music.

Altar Linen Care	The care of the altar and church linens is important to the celebration of the Mass. Well prepared altar linens serve as a sign of reverence for what is celebrated on the altar of the Lord, as well as a protection of the altar and the sacred vessels.

RCIA Team Member and	The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a program for people interested in the
Faith Formation	Catholic faith, whether they are non-Catholics thinking about becoming Catholic, or Catholics who wish to learn more about their baptismal Catholic faith.
	The goal of Faith Formation is to assist parents in the religious education of their children and to help them prepare to receive the Sacraments. The Faith Formation program is offered to children who attend public school.
Visiting the Sick and	Those who visit and/or bring Holy Communion to those at home, in hospital or care
Homebound	homes are offering a ministry of spiritual care. A minister of care is commissioned by
	the parish to bring Holy Communion and the compassion of Christ and His Church to
	the sick and the homebound. Visiting the sick, the grieving, the aged, the dying is a
	ministry of sharing Christ with others. Training for this is provided.
