

RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION AT IC PARISH

Dear Parishioners,

In the Church document of March 25, 2004, **Redemptionis Sacramentum** (Sacrament of Redemption) issued by the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, certain matters related to the Eucharist (Holy Mass) are explained.

<u>Paragraphs 90-92</u> of the document provide explanations, and approvals, about:

- one's <u>posture</u> for receiving the Body of Christ: standing <u>or</u> kneeling are approved; and
- 2. <u>how</u> one can receive the Body of Christ: in the hand <u>or</u> on the tongue are approved.

It has been brought to my attention that some Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC) are hesitant to distribute the Body of Christ on the tongue due to the contagious illnesses that have made their way through our parish, and that continue to affect the health of our parishioners.

Therefore, for the foreseeable future, and as a means of providing for the various needs of our parishioners, I would invite those who wish to receive the Body of Christ <u>on the tongue</u> to receive in my line during the distribution of Holy Communion. In turn, I would invite those who wish to receive in the hand to receive in my line **OR** in the line of the EMHC.

Most of all, I ask that we remember St. Paul's words that we, although made up of "many parts", form "**one body**" (1 Corinthians 12:12). And let us remember Christ's own prayer to our Heavenly Father: that we Christians "**may all be one**" (John 17:21).
