HIGHLIGHTS OF NOVEMBER 8, 2023 Parish Pastoral Council (PPC) Meeting

- Advent Program: Fr. Matthew will offer a series of reflections on the "O Antiphons".
- Parish Survey: This survey will help PPC to prioritize needs in the parish.
- Repeal section 43 of the Canadian Criminal Code

Section 43 of the Criminal Code currently states: "Every schoolteacher or person standing in place of a parent is justified in using force by way of correction toward a pupil or child who is under his care, if force does not exceed what is reasonable under the circumstances. R.S.C., 1985, c. C-4"

NDP Member of Parliament has tabled a Private Member's Bill (C-273) in the House of Commons calling for a repeal of this section of the Criminal Code of Canada. The bill is now scheduled for a vote.
