

Ash Wednesday-February 14, 2024



Mass times:

- 9AM with IC School
- 7PM in the evening

On this first day of Lent, we receive

ashes on our foreheads in the form of a cross, with the words "*Repent and believe in the gospel*". The cross of ashes is a sign of our faith and a reminder of repentance for our sins.

With these ashes, we recall our origins from the earth, as well as how our bodies shall return one day to the same form (as indicated by the dictum "*Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return*").

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are universal days of Fasting and Abstinence in the Church. Fasting, for all those who are 18 to 59 years of age, and in reasonable health, and abstinence from meat for those 14 and older. Parents and educators are the greatest influence in modelling these practices to children to help them understand their importance.

Fasting is one of the three pillars of Lent, along with prayer and almsgiving. It is a practice of self-discipline with a focus on penance intended to strengthen our faith and serve as a witness of our faith. It allows us to share in the suffering of those who are hungry.

Whereas Ash Wednesday takes a more somber tone as the start of 40 days of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Both days are steeped in tradition, and although Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day might seem like a clash or create a conflict, when you reflect on the significance of these two days, they have a lot more in common, both Ash Wednesday and Valentine's Day are about the human need for love and acceptance.


ST. VINCENT DE PAUL
